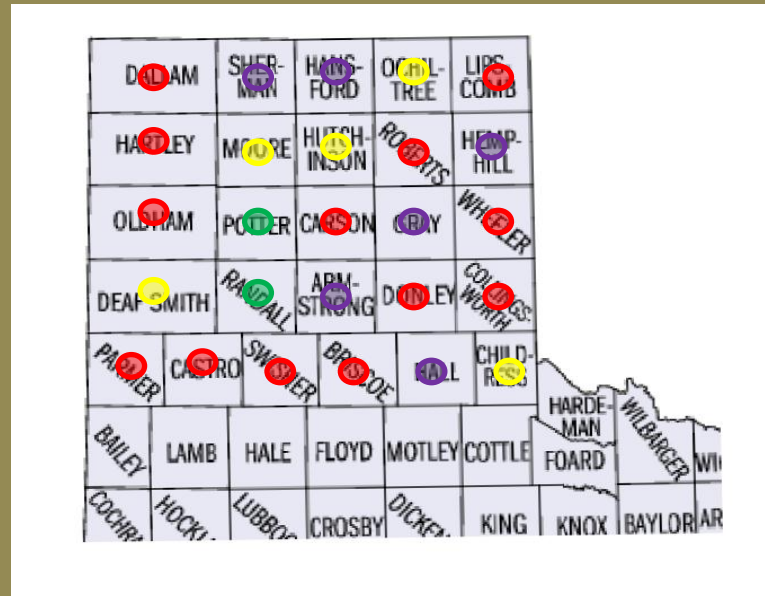
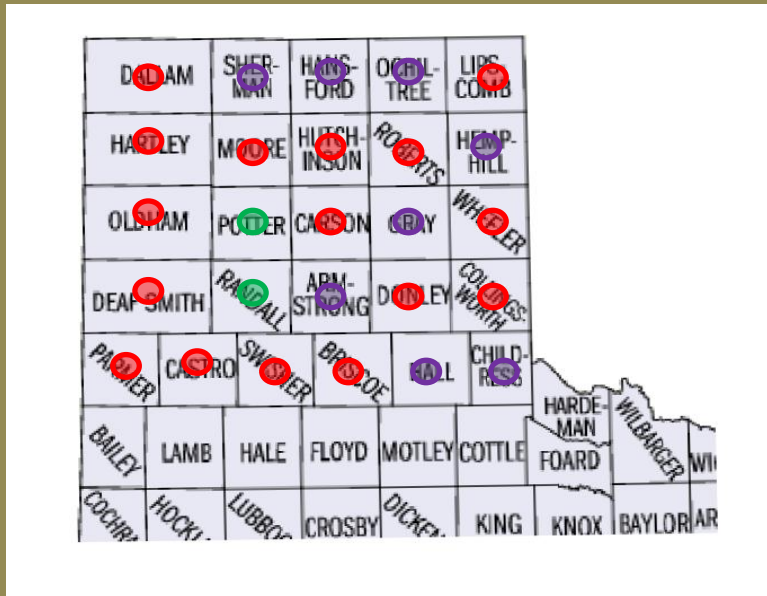




COG1 Target Area

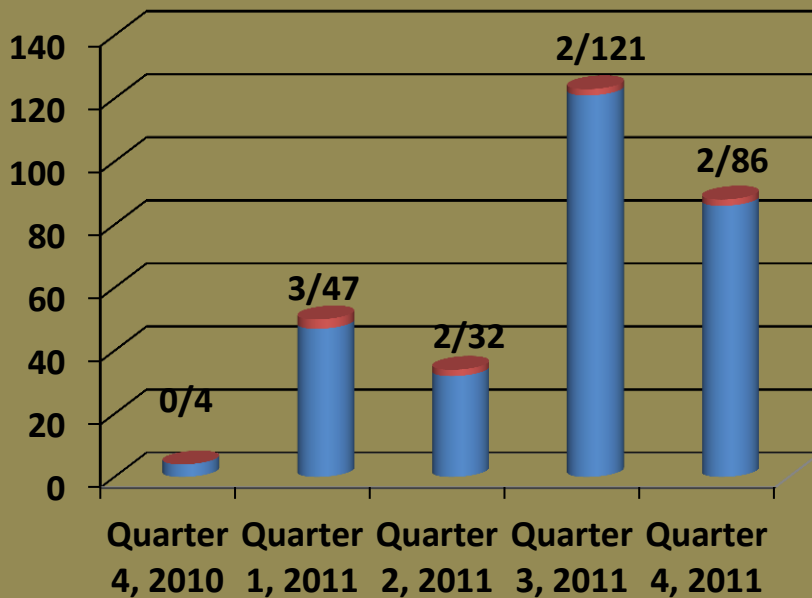

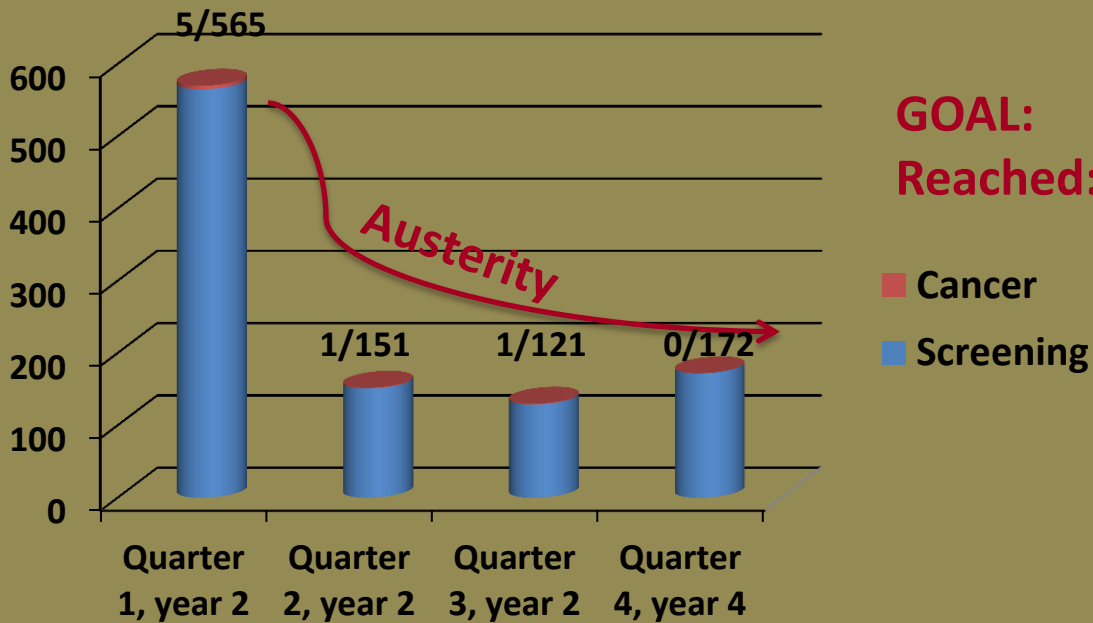
